Qualifying (Saturday all day & Sunday morning)

6 games, bowled as 1 x 6 game block at doubles pace over 12 lanes, moving lanes every 2 2 games.

Squad A bowls 1 x 6 game block between 9am & 12pm on Saturday.

Squad B bowls 1 x 6 game block between 12-30pm & 3-30pm on Saturday.

Squad C bowls 1 x 6 game block between 4pm and 7pm on Saturday.

Squad D bowls 1 x 6 game block between 8-30am & 11-30am on Sunday.

Registration will be 30 mins prior to the squad time.

These (scratch) scores will class as qualification scores for NAYBC tour rankings.

Top 36 bowlers from qualifying will proceed to the finals and be ranked based on handicap pin fall over the 6 games.

****Should any bowler who has qualified for the finals not attend to bowl, they will be replaced by the next highest ranked bowler who is present. This bowler will simply replace the missing bowler in the group they were placed to bowl in****

Finals (Sunday afternoon, 12pm registration).

All scores will reset to ZERO for the finals.

Group Stage;

Top 36 bowlers will be separated into 6 x groups of 6 as follows;

Group A bowlers ranked 1, 12, 13, 24, 25 & 36.

Group B bowlers ranked 2, 11, 14, 23, 26 & 35.

Group C bowlers ranked 3, 10, 15, 22, 27 & 34.

Group D bowlers ranked 4, 9, 16, 21, 28 & 33.

Group E bowlers ranked 5, 8, 17, 20, 29 & 32.

Group F bowlers ranked 6, 7, 18, 19, 30 & 31.

Each group will then proceed to bowl one 3 x game block against the other bowlers in their group at trios pace on one pair of lanes.

Top 2 bowlers in each group based on their total 3 x game handicap pin fall will proceed through to the scramble round.

In the event of a tie, the bowler with the highest low game (inclusive of handicap) will proceed.

Scramble;

12 bowlers qualifying from the group stage will be placed in 2 x groups of 6 as follows;

Group 1 – Winners from groups A, C & E along with runners up from groups B, D & F.

Group 2 – Winners from groups B, D & F along with runners up from groups A, C & E.

Each group will then bowl and lose the lowest scoring bowler (inclusive of handicap) each game over 5 x games until only 1 x bowler remains in each group. These 2 x bowlers will qualify for the grand final.

Grand Final;

2 bowlers qualifying from the scramble will bowl 2 x games and the bowler with the highest 2 x game pin fall will be declared the winner.

Presentation will be at 6pm.

****Above is based on 96 entries. Should entries be 72 or lower, squad C will be removed and bowlers proceeding through to the final will be reduced from 36 to 30****

PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

Before, during, and after the event there could be photography, filming or video taken of participants and medal winners by anyone attending the event, either as an official, spectator, parent or guardian.

If you (as a participant, parent or guardian) object to this, you must make your objections known to the tournament manager prior to the event starting and reasonable adjustments will be made."

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This is a B.T.B.A. tour event and will be sanctioned by the B.T.B.A. their rules will govern the event along with the following special rules and conditions.
2. The tournament is open to bowlers who are 21 years old or younger on the 31st August 2020.
3. All bowlers shall be current members of the BTBA. Membership dates will be checked online by tournament management. If a bowler's membership has expired the bowler can renew online or they may be unable to bowl.
4. This will be a handicap tournament throughout, with bowler's handicap being calculated on 80% of 220.
5. Entrants must declare their highest average in any league, tournament or merit table over 21 games on the day of bowling. Y.B.C. officials/bowlers must submit a current league standing sheet seven days prior to bowling.
6. The tournament managers are Mike Cummings & Mark Stoner.
7. The tournament managers reserve the right to refuse or rerate any entry if they consider there is just cause to do so. Protests must be lodged by the Y.B.C. official / bowler within 30mins.
8. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pin fall cannot be resolved immediately. The tournament manager's decision is final subject to appeal to the B.T.B.A.
9. No competitor will be allowed to smoke or consume alcohol anywhere in the centre during the tournament. Any breach of this rule will result in immediate disqualification of the individual concerned.
10. Profane Language, improper gestures or abuse of bowling equipment / machinery may also result in disqualification
11. Any disqualification may result in loss of scores / awards. Any bowler whose conduct is likely to bring the sport into disrepute will also be disqualified. Any individual disqualified will be reported to the B.T.B.A. for consideration of disciplinary proceedings.
12. Competitors who are not dressed in correct bowling attire in the bowler's area will not be permitted to bowl. Shirts should contain YBC / bowlers name. Boys shall wear dark coloured trousers or tailored shorts. Girls shall wear dark coloured skirt, skorts, trousers or sports leggings. Denim jeans, tracksuit bottoms / jogging bottoms/cargo pants or shorts of any colour will not be permitted.
13. Mobile phones should be turned off and not used in the bowling area.
14. Only tournament officials, bowlers and licensed coach/YBC official will be allowed in the playing area. YBC officials and coaches must adhere to the dress code laid down in the tournament rules.
